2. Be able to effectively communicate in English (reading/writing/speaking).

3. Be able to participate in the whole program online (Camera/Microphone set ON over Zoom) with stable internet connection at home.

4. Be able to participate in <u>all</u> programs from DAY 1 to DAY 5 (Selective participation NOT permitted).

- Having a strong interest in Japan and ASEAN countries.
- Willing to interact with peers from Japan and ASEAN countries.
- Having a strong interest to contribute to solving social issues in your community and the global society

- 1. Fill out the application form and essay on the next page. Please submit it to the contact person in each country/school. Application deadline: Friday, September 30, 2022
- 2. After reviewing the essays meticulously, the administration office will select the participants. We will inform you of the outcome by the end of October.
